

Proposed Amendments to Rule 66

Rule 66 is amended as follows:

Rule 66. Receivers Appointed by Federal Courts.

~~—— An action wherein a receiver has been appointed shall not be dismissed except by order of the court. The practice in the administration of estates by receivers or by other similar officers appointed by the court shall be in accordance with the practice heretofore followed in the courts of the United States or as provided in~~ **These** rules promulgated by the district courts. In all other respects the **govern an** action in which the appointment of a receiver is sought or ~~which~~ **a receiver sues or** is brought by or against a receiver is governed by these rules. **sued. But the practice in administering an estate by a receiver or a similar court-appointed officer must accord with the historical practice in federal courts or with a local rule. An action in which a receiver has been appointed may be dismissed only by court order.**
