Specific Instructions – Form 23 is added as follows:

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS - FORM 23

FORM 23

As provided in Rule 80(h), Form 23 is intended to be used when a party submits a physical sample to the court other than as provided in USCIT R. 73.1 (for USCIT R. 73.1, CBP transmits entries, protests, other documents and samples via CBP Form 322 which the Clerk's office posts as an attachment to the docket entry which notes that the entries have been received). The filing of Form 23 provides public notice through CM/ECF that a sample was made in connection with a specific docket entry. The submission of a physical sample should include the name of the party, a general description of the merchandise, and the docket entry to which it relates.
