**JUDGMENT**

The plaintiffs having filed challenges to certain findings of the defendant International Trade Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce (“ITA”) *sub nom. Circular Welded Carbon Steel Pipes and Tubes From Thailand: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review*, 73 Fed.
