The United States Court of International Trade is inviting members of its bar to submit statements of interest in being appointed to its Rules Advisory Committee. The Rules Advisory Committee was established pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2077(b), and its mission is to consider, study, and make recommendations concerning the rules of practice and operating procedures of the Court, consistent with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the statutes impacting the Court's jurisdiction, and other developments that may affect the work of the Court.

The Committee meets approximately four times per year, alternating between New York City and Washington, D.C., and will meet and/or communicate in smaller groups, as necessary. The success of the Committee is dependent upon its members' willingness and ability to devote significant time and effort to its work. Appointments are for renewable five-year terms. Please note that the Court is unable to reimburse Committee members for travel or other expenses associated with serving on the Committee.

Attorneys should submit a written statement of interest, addressing any prior involvement with the Court, familiarity with the Court's rules, and ability to contribute to the work of the Committee.
