

CERTIFICATION OF APPENDIX CONTENTS

By checking the boxes below, I hereby certify that the foregoing appendix complies with the requirements set forth in Judge Baker's instructions to counsel in § 1581(c) cases:

- The appendix contains no more than 2500 pages or leave of court has been granted to exceed that limit. (¶ 3.1)
- All required material appears at the beginning of the appendix:
 - The entirety of the agency's final decision, including any Federal Register notice or other document pending publication and any supporting memoranda (preliminary or otherwise) created by the agency bearing on those aspects of its decision challenged in this court. (¶¶ 3.3, 3.10.b)
 - The entirety of all administrative briefing submitted by the parties bearing on those aspects of agency decision challenged in this court, except that exhibits and other evidentiary materials are omitted unless cited in the parties' CIT briefing. (¶¶ 3.3, 3.10.b)
- All cited and contextual confidential record material follows the required material, arranged in chronological order. (¶ 3.4.b.ii)
 - In the sealed appendix, no document is redacted. (¶ 3.4.b.iii & n.3; ¶ 3.8 & n.11)
 - Every confidential record page in the sealed appendix has a redacted counterpart (from the public record or otherwise) bearing the same Appx page number in the public appendix. (¶ 3.8)
- All cited and contextual unredacted public record material follows the cited and contextual confidential material, again arranged in chronological order. (¶¶ 3.4.b.iii, 3.8)
- The sealed and public appendices have identical contents and matching Appx pagination. (¶ 3.8)
- If this is a remand appendix, it omits any record material included in any previous joint or remand appendix. (¶ 3.10.c)

- Appx-style Bates numbers appear in the format required by the Federal Circuit for appendices filed with that court. (¶ 3.4.c)
 - The Appx page numbers appear centered in the footer and meet the font size requirements of Fed. R. App. P. 32(a)(5). (¶ 3.4.c)
 - The Appx page numbers are at least half an inch from the bottom of the page to ensure legibility when printed. (¶ 3.4.c)
 - The Appx page numbers are searchable text. (¶ 3.4.c)
 - The record pages have not been shrunk using software to make room for the Appx page numbers. Instead, any conflicting material is redacted. (¶ 3.4.c)
 - If this is a remand appendix, the Appx page numbers continue the sequence from the last page of the original Appx page numbering. (¶ 3.10.d)
- If the appendix contains multiple volumes, the full table of contents or index appears at the beginning of every volume and the cover page for each volume includes its Bates-page range. (¶¶ 3.7, 3.9)
- The docket description I provide the CM/ECF system will include the Appx Bates-page range for each volume. (¶ 3.9)
