



Intern Applicants:

Judge Choe-Groves accepts intern applications from students who have completed at least 2 years of law school. The U.S. Court of International Trade is an Article III court with national jurisdiction located in New York City. Applicants must submit a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, college transcript, and a writing sample via email. Applicants demonstrating an interest in international trade law are considered in ranking applications. Interns will work directly with law clerks. Please note that all internships are unpaid positions. U.S. citizens are preferred.

Deadlines for applications are as follows: November 1 for spring applicants, February 1 for summer applicants, and August 1 for fall applicants. Internships may be located remotely if the situation so warrants. Only applicants selected for an interview will be notified.
